WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

- LSU Carolinas will work with the other state chapters to collect a total of 300 applications by July 1.
- **We will HOLD your payment and application until 300 paid applications are collected.**
- Once a minimum of 300 applications are collected, we will submit the applications and payment to NC DMV – we will contact you to notify you when the applications are sent to NC DMV.
- Following submission of paid applications to NC DMV, it will be at least two months for NC DMV to print the plates and distribute.

IMPORTANT ITEMS TO NOTE:

- Plate numbering will begin at 0026 and go to 9999, after 9999 letters and numbers will be used.
 - First 25 plates are designated for the officers of the various state chapters and are not accessible.
- Specialty NC license plates (Blue Ridge Highway, Friends of the Smokies, etc.) will not be able to be used with the LSU designation.
- Personalized LSU plates are available for an additional \$30 (\$55 total).
 - Any type of letter or symbol, but plate text cannot be all numbers (4 spaces available for text).
- You do not have to be an official alumnus of LSU to purchase the LSU NC plate.
